

**COVID Grade Impact 2020-2021 School Year
AB104 Policy**



- 1). HS learners w/ NC/D's are updated to (P) Pass w/ course units and no negative impact to the GPA for the 2020-2021 school year
- 2). HS learners w/ NC/F are updated to (NP) No Pass w/out course units and no negative impact to the GPA for the 2020-2021 school year.
- 3). HS learners who received a B or C grade in a course during the 2020-2021 school year may also opt for a Pass option w/ course units and no negative impact to the GPA. The request must be made by families within 15 days of notification of the policy. [Link to the form on cde.ca.](#)

ACLC Repeat Credit Policy

- All attempts of a course will show up in historical grades and on the official transcript.
- An A to G course may be repeated only if a grade of NC/D, NC/F, D+/-, F, or no pass (NP) is received for the first attempt of the course.
- An A to G course may be repeated one time to replace a grade. If the course is not passed with a grade of C or higher the third attempt at the course will not be calculated into your GPA, but will be shown on your transcript.
- If you earned a grade of NC/D, NC/F, D+/-, F, or no pass (NP) in an A to G course required for graduation you must repeat the course and receive a passing grade.
- If you have repeated no more than 4 core classes, the grade from the second attempt of the course will go into your GPA and the grade from the first attempt will come out, regardless of which grade is higher.
- If you have repeated more than 4 core classes, grades from both the first and second attempts will be calculated into your GPA.
