Do Your Work. Do Your Own Work.

- When working on your course, take your time. Reading carefully will save you time in the end.
- Feeling stuck? You can <u>Live Chat</u> with a tutor or email your teacher for help.
- Only submit original work. Taking someone else's work or words and using them as your own is plagiarism.
- Plagiarized assignments will be given zeros. Multiple instances may result in a failing grade (see the Plagiarism Policy).
- Examples of plagiarism include:
 - o Copying and pasting text found on the Internet or other published sources without proper citation.
 - o Submitting other students' work as your own.
 - o Using an answer key you found online to complete an assignment or test.

Submit Your Work

- Message your teacher from your dashboard if you need help or will be unable to submit work on time.
- Use the <u>ALVS Guide for Completing and Submitting Work</u> to learn how to submit different types of assignments.



Read Your Teacher's Feedback

- Set up an alert to be instantly notified via email or text when your assignments are graded or your teacher has emailed you. Set alerts by clicking on your name, and then My Profile > Preferences.
- Check your messages often for grades and feedback from your teacher.
- Assignments will be graded within three school days. However, if you submit more than three assignments in a single day, they
 will be graded within five school days.
