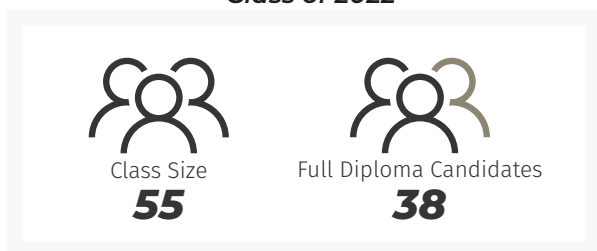

## A Statement About COVID-19

In February 2020, in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, TCIS closed its campus in compliance with the national and local government mandates. We immediately adjusted the instructional format for online delivery. That change was made with no interruption to learning and no changes to academic requirements or standards. We reopened our campus in May of 2020, and since that time, we have maintained 100% face-to-face academic instruction. TCIS has now begun the 2021-2022 school year in a face-to-face format, with health and safety protocols in place, as well as modifications to our activities programs.

### Class Rank and Grading System

- Grades are recorded on the transcript at the end of each semester.
- GPA is calculated for grades earned at TCIS only, based on the final year-long grade in each class.
- TCIS utilizes a 4.0 unweighted scale for MYP courses and a 4.0 weighted scale for DP courses.
- IB DP Standard Level (SL) courses are weighted 0.25 points.
- IB DP TOK is weighted 0.25 points.
- IB DP Higher Level (HL) courses are weighted 0.5 points.
- TCIS does not rank its students.

If questions about student discipline are asked, TCIS will honestly report out-of-school suspensions and expulsions including but not limited to acts of violence, sexual misconduct, and academic honesty infractions to colleges and universities.



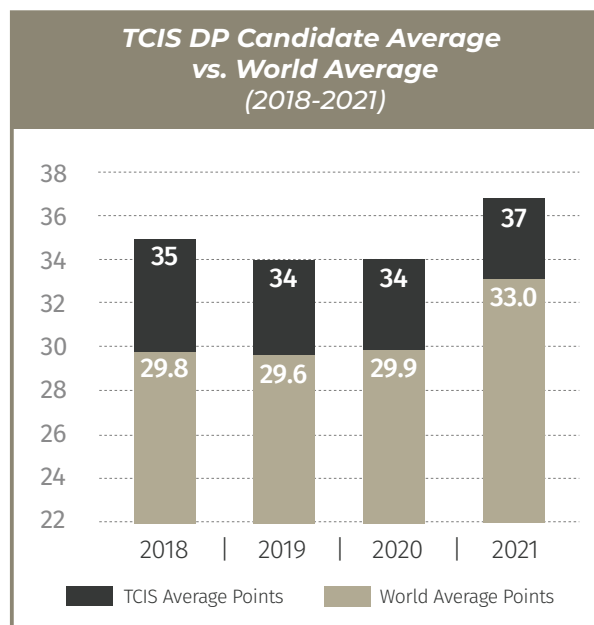
## TCIS Class of 2021 IB Diploma Highlights

- ★ Highest individual score: **45 out of 45** (two students)
- ★ **83%** of the 2021 class attempted the full IB Diploma.
- ★ **100%** of DP Candidates received their IB Diploma.
- ★ Average points of all TCIS DP recipients: **37**
- ★ Points above world average: **4**
- ★ **100%** of DP Candidates earned passing scores on EE and TOK.
- ★ **43%** of IB Diploma recipients received the bilingual diploma.
