COVID-19 STATEMENT

Region 15 public schools closed on March 13, 2020 through the end of the 2019-2020 school year as a result of the COVID-19 health crisis. Grades for the first semester are included on the transcript and calculated in student's Cumulative Weighted and Unweighted GPA. During the time that students were following the Emergency Remote Learning model, they were able to complete rigorous graded assignments that allowed them to complete their curriculum standards for each course. Following the grading guidance of the CT State Dept. of Education all PHS students were assessed with an overall grade of Pass or Fail for the second semester.

COMMUNITY

The towns of Middlebury (pop. 7,725) and Southbury (pop. 19,572) are suburban residential communities located 40 miles west of Hartford. Both communities have attracted Fortune 500 corporations to locate their headquarters in the region. Middlebury is the home of Timex and Southbury is the home of IBM. The work force of the region is predominantly professional, managerial and skilled, providing stability to the economic development of both communities.
