

Current Health Policies/Procedures

- **Temperature Monitoring** - Any student with a temperature of or greater than 100.0 F (oral) or 99.5 (temporal) will be excluded from school. The student may return when fever-free for 24 hours without fever-reducing medication.
- **Sending Sick Students Home from School** - Students exhibiting symptoms from the Covid-19 Symptom Table below will be sent home from school and advised to seek further medical evaluation from their health care provider.
- **Standing Order on Medications** - Due to Covid-19 interactions, medication such as Tylenol, Ibuprofen, and TUMS will not be administered to a student unless that student has a medication order from their own private healthcare provider.
- **Monitoring for Symptoms** - Monitor your child’s temperature before sending them to school. If your child is sick with symptoms of Covid-19 (SEE BELOW), keep your child home from school and consult with your child’s healthcare provider.

Please do not send your child to school with an injury or illness for the nurse to diagnose.

COVID-19 SYMPTOM TABLE

The individual must be fever-free (under 100.0 - oral) for 24 hours without fever-reducing medication **and symptoms are improved prior to returning to school.
