Dear Parent or Guardian,

To make sure we give the best possible education and services to students at Keefe Tech, we want to learn about their attitudes and behaviors with regard to a variety of health issues. In order to accomplish this, students at Keefe Tech are being asked to participate in a survey called the *MetroWest Adolescent Health Survey*. Keefe Tech has been participating in this survey since 2008. The questions on the survey cover many health related topics including alcohol, tobacco and other drug use; violence and safety; nutrition and physical activity; sexual behaviors; online behaviors and mental health; and protective factors. This project will help Keefe Tech develop and enhance its health education and prevention services. We will be giving this online survey to students in all grade levels on **Tuesday, November 2nd**.

The survey is **anonymous**, meaning your child will not be asked to provide their name, and no one know how they respond. There will be no identifying information collected on the survey, and there will be no way to link your child's responses to their identity.

Completing this survey is **voluntary**. Your child's grades in school will not be affected by whether or not they participate. Your child can also decide not to take the survey or skip any question they don't wish to answer.

The *Protection of Pupil Rights Amendment* is a Federal Law that requires us to notify you ahead of time about the survey, and give you the chance to look at it, so you can let us know if you don't want your child to take part. If you want to see the survey before deciding, a copy will be available in the School Counseling Office at Keefe Tech from October 26 to October 29.
