## Web Posting Required for 2019-20 Education Protection Account

The passage of Proposition 30 from the November 2012 elections created the Education Protection Account to collect the temporary increase in taxes through December 2018 and continues with the passage of Proposition 55 in November 2016. Proposition 55 will remain in effect through December 2030.

SBUSD spent \$2,587,770 for fiscal year 2018-19 on unrestricted instructional salaries and expects to spend \$2,531,876 for fiscal year 2019-20. The district projects to receive \$2,493,452 for fiscal year 2020-21, which will be received quarterly. All funds received and spent will be tracked in the budget using resource code 1400 and will be used for unrestricted instructional salaries and benefits.
