





*Tools > Voice Typing

*Tips:

- Use a clear voice close to the screen.
- Use in a place with minimal ambient noise.
- Insert final punctuation.
- Discuss implementation (brainstorming vs single word insertion)

Google Read&Write (free version)

*Pin extension to browser bar.

*Use settings to eliminate inaccessible tools.

*Change reading rate.

*Use for text reading vs editing.
