Halloween Fun Run

It is fundraising time for the school again. Each year a few fundraisers take place. The Fall Festival was a way for our PTA to raise funds to go toward our PTA sponsored events. The school usually holds their Wasatch Savings fundraiser to help raise funds for our classrooms and school needs. We have also done a fun run in the past. Each fundraiser is extremely helpful to our school in raising the much-needed funding to help better our classrooms.

This year we have decided to forgo the selling of our Wasatch Savings books and change up our 5K and consolidate both of our school fundraisers into one. It's time to come out and participate in our

Halloween Fun Run!! Instead of our 5K, we will do this fun run at our school.

Things are a little different this year!

Every student is encouraged to come and participate in our Fun run! Participation is free for all. Anyone, student, adult, or families can run the laps for your own enjoyment. However, here is the catch. Since we are trying to help the school earn money for the school, we ask that each of your children take pledges. The pledges can be given by family, friends, neighbors, or anyone else that you feel comfortable asking. Kids will ask someone to pledge money towards their run. The pledge can be made per lap (i.e. For every lap John runs, I will pay \$5) or they can make just a flat donation. Each lap is 1/5th of a mile and is what they are used to running in PE. This fund raiser allows for us to keep all the money donated and given to our school.
