DESCRIPTION OF EXCELLENCE



BIBLE DEPARTMENT FACULTY

Our Bible Department faculty includes teachers with master's or doctoral degrees; most instructors have taught at VCS between five and twenty-four years. Many are active in local church ministries.

BIBLE DEPARTMENT DISTINCTIVES

- Every year, teams of VCS students and faculty travel the world on short-term service trips to Liberia, Chile, Mexico, El Salvador, Nepal, Israel, Philippines, Slovakia, and Thailand.
- VCHS students tutor and develop relationships with students at local underserved public elementary schools.
- All VCHS students complete a minimum 25 hours of community service annually as part of the Bible class curriculum.
- The Bible Department participates in VCHS' Dual Credit Program, which allows students to take specified classes for college credits.



BIBLE COURSES

Four years of Bible are required to graduate from VCHS.

Bible placement is determined by a survey and the Bible department teachers. Students must take Philosophy of Religion/World Religions and one Service Learning Course in their junior or senior years.
