BIBLE DEPARTMENT FACULTY

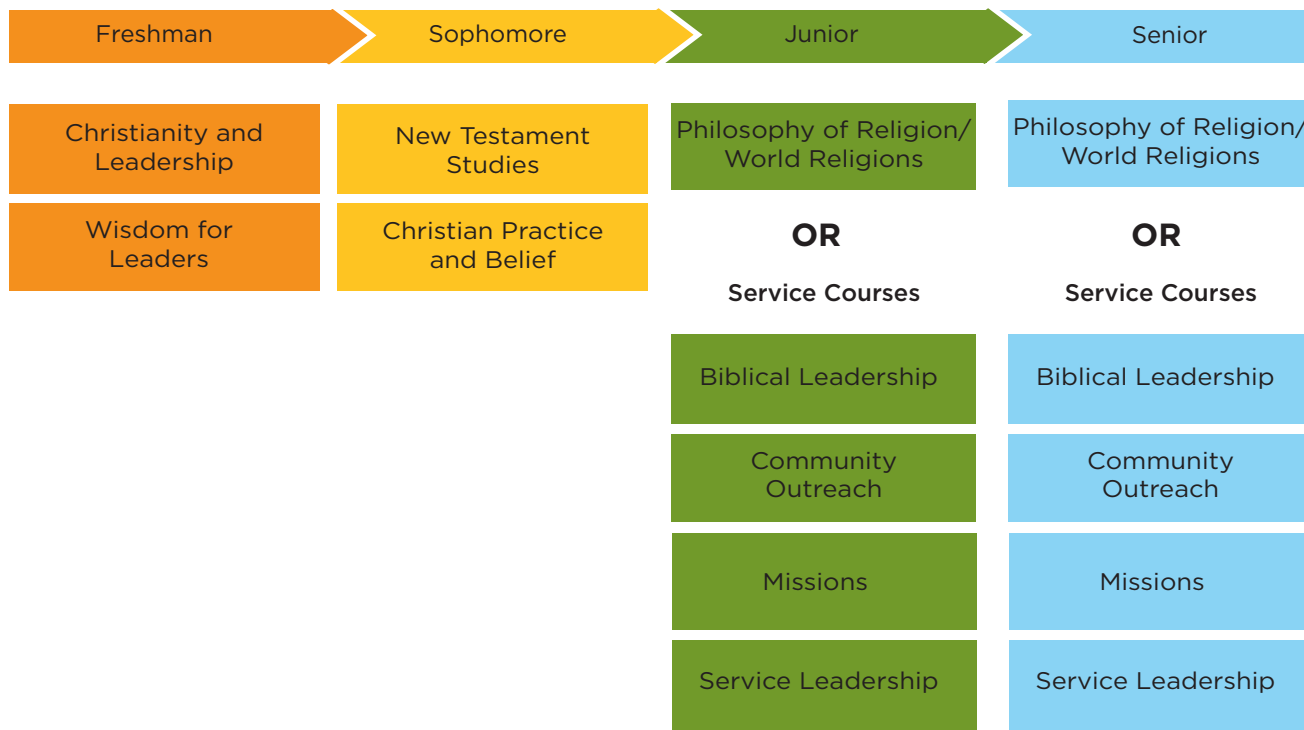
Our Bible Department faculty includes twelve teachers with master's or doctoral degrees; the average instructor has taught at VCS ten years. All are involved in vocational ministry outside of VCHS.

BIBLE DEPARTMENT DISTINCTIVES

- Every year, teams of VCS students and faculty travel the world on short-term service trips to South Africa, Liberia, Chile, Haiti, India, Mexico, and Thailand
- VCHS students tutor and develop relationships with students at local underserved public elementary schools.
- All VCHS students complete a minimum 25 hours of community service annually as part of the Bible class curriculum.
- The Bible Department participates in VCHS' Dual Credit Program, which allows students selecting certain classes to take those for college credit.

BIBLE COURSES

Four years of Bible are required to graduate from VCHS.

Students must take Philosophy of Religion/World Religions and one Service Course in their junior or senior years.
