
CURRICULUM COVERAGE

English and Destination Reader

In English and DR This term we will be reading the heart-warming story, 'A Boy Called Christmas'.by Matt Haig. *Where an impossibility is just a possibility you don't understand.*

Some of the genres we will be covering through this text will be report writing, recount and poetry.

During this term and next, we will also use the text 'Stone Age Boy' by Satoshi Kitamura to support children's learning in history.



Phonics and spelling

Spellings! This term we will continue to work through spelling rules and applying all the phonic knowledge we have learnt previously. Spellings will be coming home weekly, and Friday will be our spelling test day. You can still access these on spelling shed if you want to get some extra practice in!

Maths

Over the coming term, the main focus will be on addition and subtraction. This will include mental strategies for both operations, estimating and formal calculations. Throughout the term, children will continue to develop their skills of reasoning and problem solving.

Science

In science this term we will be learning about animals including humans. The children will learn about nutrition and diet. They will also learn about the skeleton, muscles, tendons and ligaments.

History

The main history theme will continue over two terms and will cover changes in Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age. This term we will cover these areas of learning: What was civilisation like in the Stone Age? Where in history did the Stone Age occur? How do we know about the Stone Age and everyday life in the Stone Age?
