We are continuing with our theme of World War II, focussing on the holocaust.

Our focus of Powerful Knowledge will be based upon the reoccurring themes of *Invasion, Conquest /conflict, Equality and Status and hierarchy* and the impact that WWII had on the Jewish community.

Pupils to know about the Holocaust

The term used for the killing of over 6 million Jews and other groups.

Carried out by the Nazi's party throughout the war. These groups were persecuted and discriminated against in a variety of ways.

CURRICULUM COVERAGE

English and Destination Reader

In English and DR we will be reading *Once* by Morris Gleitzman. This book is about a young Jewish boy who is determined to escape the orphanage he lives in to save his Jewish parents from the Nazis in the occupied Poland of the Second World War. We will then be moving onto *Anne Frank's Diary*.

Maths

Over the coming term we will be covering the following: adding and subtracting fractions, multiplying fractions, fractions of amounts and addition and subtraction.

Science

In science this term we will looking at planning our own scientific experiments involving materials. The children will be comparing materials, changes of state, reversible and irreversible changes.

History

We will be learning about Hitler's rise to power, the growth of the Nazi party and his plan to persecute millions of Jews. The children will celebrate the end of the war by learning about VE Day.
