And long nights rest.

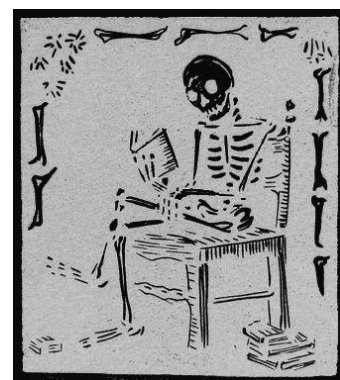
I'm from a library,
