## DIRECTIONS TO REGISTER

- Complete this form entirely, including the question in the shaded box.
- Submit form and payment prior to **November 3**. Registrations received after November 3 will still be accepted, but the testing fee will increase.
  - **If paying by check or cash**, bring this completed registration form and payment to the IB office (Room 232 in Student Services).
  - **If paying by credit card**, parents/guardians may visit Infinite Campus and select the School Store tab. Click "View" on the Cooper High School icon, and then select the AP Testing option. Add each appropriate testing course to your cart, and complete your transaction. **Reminder: if you pay by credit card and qualify for Educational Benefits, you must submit your 2023-24 eligibility letter.**

While students are not required to test, testing is the only way that students can earn potential college credit. Tests are scored on a scale of 1 - 5. Typically colleges grant credit for scores of 3 or higher. How much credit is received varies by college, but at the University of Minnesota, a score of 3 or higher on the biology test will allow a student to earn four credits; a score of 3 or higher on the Environmental Science test will allow a student to earn 3 credits. **Currently, the cost for one credit at the University of Minnesota is over \$500.** With an AP registration fee of \$50, testing could potentially be a cost-savings decision down the road.
