

**TOWN OF SCARBOROUGH
COUNCIL POLICY
ON HOLIDAY SIGNS AT TOWN HALL
ADOPTED BY TOWN COUNCIL
APRIL 16, 2003**

The purpose of this policy is to communicate the intent of the Scarborough Town Council, as it relates to Christmas holiday signs and to serve as a reaffirmation of the Council's approval to permit the placement of a single, "Merry Christmas" or "Happy Holidays" sign on municipal property.

Such a sign may be placed in front of Town Hall and not be erected before the first Sunday following Thanksgiving and shall be removed no later than the first Sunday following New Years. Any organization desiring to place such a sign shall make their intentions known to the Town Manager annually. In the event the Town Manager receives more than one notification, preference shall be granted to the organization in the prior year.
