This form and payment are due back to the IB Office by Thursday, November 4, 2021. Late fees will apply after that date.

While students are not required to test, testing is the only way that students can earn potential college credit. Tests are scored on a scale of 1 - 7; typically colleges grant credit for scores of 4 or higher. HL courses tend to earn more college credit than SL courses.

There is a misconception that SL courses will not earn college credit. While many private colleges do not, there are many institutions, including the Minnesota State College and University system, that do.

How much credit is received varies by college, but at the University of Minnesota, a score of 5 or higher on the English HL test will allow a student to earn eight credits. At Mankato State, or any other state school, a score of 4 or higher on the English SL test will allow a student to earn 2 credits. **Currently, the cost for one credit at the University of Minnesota is over \$500. At Mankato State, the cost for one credit is \$281.** With an IB registration fee of \$50, testing could potentially be a cost-savings decision down the road.

DIRECTIONS TO REGISTER

1. Complete the form entirely, including:
 - a. the questions in the shaded box;
 - b. which courses you wish to test in;
 - c. if the test fee is a hardship for your family, be sure you've completed the Scholarship Request section of the form and have a parent/guardian sign that section;
 - d. signatures from both student and parent/guardian, indicating that you acknowledge our penalty policy.
2. Submit form and payment prior to the deadline of **November 4**. Registrations received after November 4 will still be accepted, but the testing fee will increase to \$90.
 - a. **If paying by check or cash**, bring this completed registration form and payment to the IB office (Room 232 in Student Services).
 - b. **If paying by credit card**, parents/guardians may visit Infinite Campus and select the School Store tab. Click "View" on the Cooper High School icon, and then select the IB Testing option. Add each appropriate testing course to your cart, and complete your transaction. A reminder that if you pay by credit card, you do not need to submit this paper form, as you will be completing the information online.
