### Grade Point Average Scale

Nea CLC calculates grade point average on a weighted 4.0 scale. Each semester counts as five credits. Our graduation standards reflect that D's and F's do not count as passing grades in high school classes.

- A: 90 – 100% = 4.00
- B: 80 – 90% = 3.00
- C: 70 – 80% = 2.00
- D: 60 – 70% = 1.00
- F: 0 – 50% = 0
