Sept. 18 - Peoria Notre Dame

- The Varsity group was at full strength and finished 2nd out of 76 teams. The team was led by 3rd place finisher, Ethan Summer in 14:42. Jeff Luka, 13th in 15:00 and Garrett Schwan 21st in 15:09. Our top 5 time average was 15:12. In 2019, our top 5 average was 15:24. The race solidified our current ranking as the 2nd best team in Illinois behind Orland Park - Sandburg.

The team was led by Ethan Summer's 3rd place finish, clearly establishing himself as a top 10 candidate for state this year. - The team traveled out of state and competed against the 9th and 19th best teams in the U.S. York was led by Ethan Summer who finished in 15th place. The Dukes finished 6th overall. Next up will be the WSC Championship on Oct 16th at

Lyons Township.
