#### **GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS**

The academic program is organized in a modified block schedule. Students must take seven courses per semester. A full year course is awarded one credit and a semester course is awarded 0.5 credits. A student must complete 28 credits to graduate, including the Senior Project. Students must also complete at least 30 hours of service by the time of graduation.

Students gain college credit through the Advanced Placement, Seattle University Matteo Ricci and UW College in a High School programs.

#### **COLLEGE CREDIT COURSES**

Kennedy Catholic offers college credit classes through three sources: the Advanced Placement Program, the University of Washington and the Matteo Ricci College at Seattle University. College credits earned through the program are transferable to most colleges in the nation.
