Trunk or Treat - Event Details:

- Get together with your classmates, family, friends and have some fun. It is open for everyone.
- Trunkers are asked to decorate their trunk, tailgate or hatchback and provide candy for the treaters
- Family appropriate themes only. We want this to be a safe and fun event for children of all ages.
- Costumes are encouraged. No scary / violent / demonic decorations or costumes are allowed.
- Trunk-or-Treaters will spend an hour going from trunk to trunk, collecting candy from the decorated “trunkers”
- Please have enough candy for all children to have at least one piece. Pass out candy from 4:30-6:00pm. (estimate 500 kids).
- Sealed/wrapped candies only (Examples – Hershey bars, Milky Way, Jolly Rancher, NO Homemade Treats, etc.)
- Selling items is prohibited at this event
- No electricity is available
- No amplified music is allowed other than Halloween themed music.
- No profanity or vulgar language.
- Rain or shine—you may use a pop-up awning if it fits in your allotted space
- Set-up will be between 3:30 and 4:30pm. All cars must be parked in their designated spots by 3:30pm for safety measures.
- Decorations must be completed by 4:30pm. Judging by selected AP staff members will begin around 5:00pm.
- Four (4) categories will be judged. Prizes will be for: “Most Original”, “Scariest”, “Funniest” and “Least looking like a vehicle”.
- All trunks and their owners will be photographed
- Vehicles will not be permitted to move or leave your designated spot until the event conclusion - approximately 6:15pm
- Please ensure the area around your treat stop is clean and all trash removed prior to leaving
