



### **TPSD Moving To Online Purchasing For Home Sporting Events**

**TUPELO, Miss.** — In an effort to update the process for purchasing tickets to sporting events and alleviate long lines at ticket booths, tickets for all Tupelo Public School District home sporting events must be pre-ordered online beginning this weekend with the state championship swim meet at the Tupelo Aquatics Center and continuing next week with all sports.

The district has partnered with GoFan for this high-end, game management software.

“Our goal is to always look at avenues to enhance the fan experience on game days,” Tupelo High School activities director Jason Miller said. “We feel by partnering with GoFan we are taking another step toward doing just that. We’ve had games this year where fans were still in line buying tickets after play had already started. As a game-day official, you never want to see that, and now with the opportunity to pre-order tickets that will ease of the burden of entering our venues.

Fans wanting to purchase tickets will simply go to [bit.ly/WaveTix\\_2122](http://bit.ly/WaveTix_2122), choose the game(s) they want to attend, enter the number of tickets to purchase, select Get Tickets and then hit the Buy Tickets button to enter email and payment information. The buyer will then receive confirmation of purchase to present to the ushers entering the game.

For each sale, a small service fee will be added.

“This is a service that’s becoming standard everywhere,” assistant superintendent Dr. Brock English said. “It’s easy for our fans to use and will lessen the stress of long lines on game day.”
