LIBRARY NEWS

Week of September 6th

Welcome Back to the Library! Regular Library classes begin.

Mrs. Park has been busy trying to finish the inventory on the hard-backed Fiction section of the Library. Inventory is scanning each book in a particular section, noting if any repairs need to be made, any cleaning needed, if the book has been regularly checked out by students, and, if not, whether the book has literary value = whether to keep the book or discard the book based on a 14 scaled check-off list.

Library lessons this week will focus on Fiction: a made-up story either realistic, or not, which has a beginning, middle, and ending. Students will be taught the 5-Finger Rule on how to find a "Just Right" book for themselves to *GROW* their reading fluency this year!
