1. Welcome
2. Purpose
 - a. Every independent school district is required by law to have a School Health Advisory Council (Title 2, chapter 28, Section 28.004)
 - b. A group of individuals representing segments of the community to assist a district in ensuring that local community values are reflected in the district's health education instruction.
3. New Laws passed during 2021 Session
 - a. Senate Bill 9 - SHAC shall provide recommendations on curriculum related to preventing child abuse, family violence, sex trafficking and dating violence.
 - b. House Bill 1525 - Requires SHAC meetings to have the agenda publicly posted and allow for a public comment time. They must have minutes of the meetings that state the subject and content of each deliberation and each vote, order, decision, or other action taken during the meeting. There must also be an audio or video recording of the meeting. Both the minutes and the audio or video recording must be posted on the school district's website. Requires parents give written consent prior to a student receiving human sexuality instruction.

 - a. Elect a chair or co-chairs (non-employee)
