Chadli introduced new staff & teachers to the council via a printed list with pictures. Layton high is still in need of a few teacher aides.

Liz Katoa presented to the council on the workbooks that were created to go along with the health lab class. Currently 250 students are taking the class. By the end of the year 500-600 kids will use the workbooks and the lab. Approximately \$3200 has been used.

Corby presented to the council about the status of the Connection Center that is being built. Council reviewed the site plan. The hope is that the connection center will be a place to meet the social emotional needs of students. A place that can help with anxiety attacks, to get grounded and return to class. As well as academic help. The hope is that the main section will be ready for use by second term. It is expected that the 2nd portion will begin construction in January, possibly ready to go by next school year.
