Must have the ability to compose visually appealing presentations using multi-media technology and regularly present reports.

**PERFORMANCE EXPECTATIONS:** Coordinates the implementation and development of the PLC Program in an assigned school. Ensures students achieve all academic and personal development goals. Provides an atmosphere and environment conducive to the intellectual, physical, social, and emotional development of students. Monitors and evaluates student outcomes and provides data for evaluation purposes. Presents the program's objectives to the teaching staff, parents, students, and community. Organizes the procedure for the supervision and assessment of the curriculum used by each teacher. Makes sure appropriate textbooks, resources, and facilities are available. Organizes assessments according to PLC criteria. Maintains appropriate records and ensures data collection requirements are met. Promotes improved professional competence of all staff.
