QUALIFICATIONS: High school diploma or its equivalency preferred. One year of experience operating trucks or light maintenance equipment or an equivalent combination of training and experience. Good knowledge of the care and safe operation of trucks and light maintenance equipment. Must have the ability to understand and follow written and oral instructions and to keep simple records. Must be able to work with minimum supervision and as a member of a team. Must be able to work in a cooperative manner with coworkers, supervisors, managers and school administration and staff. Good knowledge of the equipment, materials, methods, practices and tools used in equipment operation. Good knowledge of the common hazards and necessary safety precautions, and ability to take safety precautions including the use of guides, helpers, signals, lighting, etc. Must have the ability to estimate time and material needs and to perform routine clerical tasks and arithmetical computations. Must have the ability to work out doors in a variety of temperatures and weather conditions. Must have sufficient strength and ability to manually move, load and unload material weighing up to 75 pounds. Must be able to use material handling equipment to move, load and unload materials as required. Applicant may be required to demonstrate skill level by completing a performance test. PERFORMANCE EXPECTATIONS: Performs manual labor loading and unloading delivery trucks and making deliveries to schools, departments and other designated locations. Loads and unloads mail, various materials, supplies and equipment in designated areas.
