## **District Education Improvement Council (DEIC) Composition**

## Professional Members<sup>1</sup>:

Chairperson

Classroom Teachers (At least two-thirds)

- designated by the Superintendent
  - one (1) classroom teacher representative from each campus
    nominated and elected by classroom teachers assigned to the campus to represent the campus at the district level
- Non-teaching Campus-Level Professionals<sup>2</sup>
- one (1) non-teaching campus professional from each of the following categories:
  - counselors/LSSP
  - librarian/media specialist
  - special education assessment staff
  - assistant principals

District-Level Professional Staff<sup>3</sup>

- two (2) District-level professional staff members
  - one (1) from Curriculum and Instruction division
  - one (1) from Administrative Services division
  - elected by members of their respective division

Parents4

- chairperson of the President's PTA Council
- one (1) parent of a student currently enrolled within the District
  - non-council representatives selected by curriculum management team

Community Members<sup>5</sup>

- minimum of two (2) members , representative of the community's diversity
  - selected by the Superintendent's Cabinet

**Business Representatives<sup>6</sup>** 

- minimum of two (2) members , representative of the community's diversity
  - · selected by the Superintendent's Cabinet

## **Ex-Officio Members**

- members of the district-level management team in curriculum and instruction
- ex-officio members are non-voting members of the NWIC

All DEIC members shall serve staggered two-year terms and shall be limited to two (2) consecutive terms on the committee.

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<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> Teaching Professional – an employee whose position requires a degree, certificate or endorsement and/or who is compensated at or above the salary schedule for teachers. A substitute teacher, employed by the district, shall be considered as a classroom teacher.

Non-teaching Professional – a campus professional who directly or indirectly serves students in a support role.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>3</sup> District-level Professional – a professional who has responsibilities at more than one campus, including, but limited to, central office staff.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>4</sup> Parent - a person who stands in parental relation to a student who is currently enrolled within the District. A parent is not an employee of the District.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>5</sup> Community Member – a person at least 18 years of age who must reside in the District. This person should represent the community's diversity and shall not be a parent.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>6</sup> Business Representative – need not reside in nor operate businesses in the District; however, these representatives should provide for adequate representation of the community's diversity.
