

TRANSPORTATION MANAGEMENT:
STUDENT TRANSPORTATION

(REGULATION)

ELIGIBILITY	<p>The Outsourced Operations Manager may permit students for whom the District does not receive state transportation funds to use District transportation, within the limits of time and space and in accordance with the guidelines in this regulation. This is limited to academy and approved courtesy transportation students.</p>
BUS STOPS	<p>All students who use District transportation shall board buses at authorized stops. Authorized bus stops shall be designated annually by the Superintendent or designee. Bus drivers shall load and unload passengers only at authorized stops. Any variance from the assigned stop must be authorized in writing in advance by the parent and approved by the principal or designee in order to protect the chain of custody. Any variance from the assigned stop should be approved for emergency health or childcare needs only.</p> <p>No bus route will have a stop outside of the assigned attendance zone without proper authorization for a student enrolled in a program not offered at the home campus.</p>
SAFETY PRECAUTIONS	<p>Safety precautions shall be exercised in bus operations at all times. If at any time the bus driver is uncertain about road or vehicle conditions, or other safety factors, the driver shall park the vehicle until safe operating conditions are assured.</p>
ATTENDANCE ZONES	<p>Attendance zones should take into consideration hazardous conditions and transport time to the affected school.</p> <p>A student living outside his or her home school attendance zone must furnish his or her transportation.</p>
