PRIVATE MUSIC
LESSONS

Private music lessons may be conducted at the secondary level by adhering to the following guidelines:

1. A student interested in private music lessons should contact the music organization teacher on the home campus to obtain information about the availability of private lessons.
2. A student shall be a currently-enrolled member of the music organization in order to be eligible for private lessons.
3. Private music lessons shall not take place during the regular school day.
4. Supervision by a District employee shall be required at all after-school lessons.
5. The supervising District employee shall not be engaged in private lesson instruction during the hours of supervision duties.
6. All fees shall be paid to the District's Fine Arts Department. The Fine Arts Department shall, in turn, make payment to each teacher providing instruction.
7. All private lesson teachers shall be approved annually by the campus principal upon recommendation of the Head Director of the appropriate music organization (band, choir, orchestra) on the campus.
8. Each campus-level music organization shall receive the approval of the appropriate District-level administrator in the District's Fine Arts Department to contract with teachers in private lesson instruction.
9. All parties (campus director, parent, student, and lesson instructor) shall be responsible for following all guidelines and procedures established by the District.
