VIDEO/FILM

All films and videotapes chosen for use in the classroom will be carefully previewed and evaluated by the teacher to meet identified instructional objectives or the age and grade level of the students.

The following guidelines will apply:

1. Parents/guardians will receive one-week advance notice when a teacher plans to show:
 - a. Elementary school students any commercial video recording that is rated PG.
 - b. Middle school students any commercial video recording that is rated PG-13.
 - c. High school students any commercial video recording that is rated R.
2. Such notice to parents/guardians will include a brief description of the contents of the video recording and the instructional objectives to be achieved.
3. Films or videotapes to be used in the classroom will be made available for review by parents/guardians in the same manner as other instructional materials, in accordance with State law. [See EF (LEGAL) and FNG (LEGAL)]
4. A parent/guardian will be allowed to request that his or her child be given an alternative activity with the same instructional objectives, in lieu of the student viewing the video.
5. Video recordings having a rating of X or NC-17 will not be shown to students in District schools at any time.

Students will not be required to participate in any survey, evaluation, or analysis without prior written consent of the student's parent or, if the student is an emancipated minor or an adult, without the prior written consent of the student that reveals certain types of information as specified at Exhibit B.
