DAILY ACTIVITIES

As early as possible at the beginning of each school day for which classes are scheduled, students in all schools shall recite the pledge of allegiance to the United States and Texas flags. Immediately following the recitation of the pledges, the schools shall provide for the observance of one minute of silence. *Texas Education Code 25.082*

The one minute of silence will be announced over the public address system to classrooms with the following words:

“As we begin another school day, let us take one minute to silently think about our day, our activities, and what we hope to accomplish.”

The one minute of silence is intended to be an individual activity. There shall be no attempt by any District employee to influence in any way another person’s thoughts during the one minute of silence.

STUDENTS

During the one minute of silence, students are expected to be seated and remain silent. They may engage in any silent activity that is not likely to interfere with or distract other students.

EMPLOYEES

Each teacher or employee, responsible for supervising students during the period of silence, shall make sure that students are seated and remain silent and do not engage in any actions that would distract or disturb others.
