CLASS PARTIES AND
PICNICS

All school-related or school-sponsored social activities must be planned and held in accordance with Board policy and established procedures. Prior approval from the principal is required.

Private birthday parties will not be held at school during regular school hours.

Parties held during the school day must be related to approved curriculum and/or student achievement and will be limited to two per year.

End-of-school parties or picnics that do not tie to curriculum or student achievement will not be held during regular school time.

SOCIAL EVENTS IN
SECONDARY
SCHOOLS

The number and type of dances and social activities to be held in a secondary school will be determined by the principal and class sponsors.

CHAPERONES

School-sponsored parties and dances must be chaperoned by persons approved by the administration according to the following guidelines:

1. Each school party must be chaperoned by an adequate number of faculty and parents to maintain order and provide a safe, secure environment.
2. Chaperones must agree to remain at the event site for the duration of the assigned duties or for the duration of the event as appropriate.

NONSCHOOL-
SPONSORED
PARTIES AND
ACTIVITIES

All non-school sponsored parties must be scheduled after school hours. If the last day of class is an approved early release day, a non-school party or picnic can be scheduled at the end of the abbreviated day.
