ORIENTATION

New student orientation is usually done online and will help you set up your student accounts, learn about financial aid, student resources, and more.

ENROLL

- Submit test scores (Smarter Balance) or take a placement test
- Meet with an advisor to select courses and your course of study
- Register for classes (get ID card, pay fees etc.)

Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

To receive financial aid (even for scholarships) you must fill out the FAFSA.

GATHER YOUR INFORMATION

YOU WILL NEED

- Social Security Numbers for student and parent (or alien registration number)
- Parent marriage/divorce/separation date (if applicable)
- Previous years tax forms as well as other untaxed benefits and retirement contributions
- Current balances of all checking and savings accounts for student and parent(s)

SIGN UP FOR AN ACCOUNT -- FSA ID

Typically takes 2-3 days to activate your account



WELDERS & FABRICATORS

Welders & Fabricators deal with working and shaping metal. Welders focus on joining pieces of metal as quickly and efficiently as possible. Fabricators deal with the entire process of cutting, welding, and assembling metal pieces. There is overlap and a welding degree can prepare you for either posiiton.

HEATING, VENTALATION, AND AIR CONDITIONING (HVAC)

HVAC Technicians work to install and maintain heating and cooling systems. They work with sheet metal and do electrical work often in small spaces like attics.

CARPENTRY

There are two categories of carpentry work: Rough and Finish. Rough carpenters typically work on the framing of a building that will then be closed in. Finish carpenters work on trim, cabinets, and other work that is visible from the outside and attention to detail is important. Cabinet making is in particularly high demand.
