Ending balance on Hand as of July 2021 -- \$26,160.54

New Business:

- Approval of August 2021 meeting minutes. Motion made by Ms. Stansell. Seconded by Ms. Guy.
- Limited Edition "Glow in the Dark" shirts are available!
 - Limited Edition shirts are \$10. Will be available for purchase in the front office. Cash or check (Mascotte Charter PTO). Families are welcome to send an envelope with your child that contains money and shirt size. Please take the time to Dojo your child's teacher so they are aware.
 - PTO board members made a motion (Renee' Cole) and seconded the motion (Gricelda Monero) via text message to spend \$2100 for 400 limited edition glow in the dark shirts.
 - PTO allowed for staff members and families to pre-order the limited edition shirt. An additional \$500 was needed. Motion made by Gricelda Monero, seconded by Ms. Stansell, via text message.
 - Please note: PTO did not purchase adult sizes for Glow in the dark and the new colors. There are plenty of adult sizes in original colors that can be purchased. Located in the front office as well.

- Spirit Days are Wednesdays and Fridays
 - New Colors have been added! Colors are purple, red, and a lighter/brighter blue. Will be available for purchase in the front office. Cash or check (Mascotte Charter PTO).  - PTO board members made a motion (Gricelda Monero) and seconded the motion (Jenny King) via text message to spend \$2400 to purchase the new color shirts.

 - Students took Star testing recently. Once reports are given to PTO for growth, incentives will be passed out to those students. Were given a timeline to arrive in October.

 - Boosterthon gave PTO one year free of offering an online spirit store. Had a total of 64 items sold, made a profit of \$116. With this being the first ever having an online store -we learned to have the store open with a shorter window. The store was open for 4 weeks, next time trying 2 weeks. Store closed on August 18, items will arrive Sept 9.
 - This store allows PTO to offer items that do not to be purchased in bulk, we do not have to store inventory. And PTO has the ability to change what is available in the store as often as needed. Goal is to have the store open four times a year.
