## RESPONSE TO COVID PANDEMIC

Following the government's COVID-19 mandate, FDR transitioned to distance learning (DL) in March 2020, and has since maintained a synchronous schedule of educational instruction that requires attendance standards and work completion similar to on-campus expectations. Students have been responsible for asynchronous learning and the utilization of instructor office hours to supplement the synchronous instruction. The government has started to allow students to go to schools for recreational activities but classes will remain via DL. In late October FDR will start a hybrid instructional program. It is anticipated that this could remain through the end of the 2021 calendar year. Standardized testing, including the ACT and SAT, has been limited, and though the borders have now opened, travel is still somewhat restricted.

## ACADEMIC PROGRAM



- Co-educational, non-residential program - Early Childhood (EC) through Grade 12.
- All high school students work towards the FDR diploma, with the possibility of earning the Official Peruvian Program (OPP) diploma as well.
- Grades 9 and 10 students follow a standards-based curriculum, either through regular classes or through the Innovation Academy (IA).
- Grades 11 and 12 students have the option of taking either individual IB subjects or the full IB Diploma to meet this requirement.
- The language of instruction is English.

## SCHOOL CALENDAR



The school year consists of 180 teacher - student contact days from August through June and is divided into two semesters. As it is in the southern hemisphere, Colegio Roosevelt follows the Peruvian calendar and observes all Peruvian holidays and breaks, including an extended summer break from mid December to mid February each year. Along with this, the school follows the US academic calendar with students taking IB exams in May each year. This is a hybrid calendar designed to meet the needs of both the local and international communities.

## OFFICIAL PERUVIAN PROGRAM (OPP)



In addition to the US and the IB diplomas, FDR offers the Official Peruvian Program (OPP) that leads to the awarding of the Official Peruvian Certificate of Studies, which is recognized worldwide. Enrollment in the OPP is open to students who are native Spanish speakers or are highly proficient in the language. An Official Peruvian Certificate of Studies is needed for Peruvian students and other Spanish speaking students applying to Peruvian universities or universities abroad that have cultural, scientific and educational agreements with Peru.

The academic strength of our students is recognized by the top ranked Peruvian universities in Latin America, who consider us a "High Performing School". They regularly award our students preferential admissions benefits based on FDR alumni graduates who achieve remarkable academic performance in their Houses of Studies.

## HIGH SCHOOL GRADING SYSTEM

FDR does not rank its students and does not provide a Grade Point Average (GPA). Student progress and learning is assessed using general descriptors aligned with the FDR grading scale. Students are assessed both on their Approaches to Learning (ATL) and their Overall Level of Achievement (OLA). The OLA marks with their descriptors are listed below.

*A note about grade equivalency: It is not possible to provide a standard comparison between IB grades and the letter grades commonly used in the US. For students moving from FDR to a US high school or university, FDR has estimated approximate equivalents between FDR grades and US grades.*

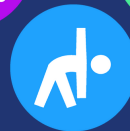
## GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

One credit is awarded for each one-year course completed with a passing mark of 3 or above based on the FDR grading scale of 2-7. One half - credit is awarded for each one-semester course completed. A minimum of 24 credits is required for graduation. Students transferring to FDR from another system may bring in a maximum of 8 credits per grade level. All students, regardless of their program, are expected to meet the requirements of the FDR Diploma.

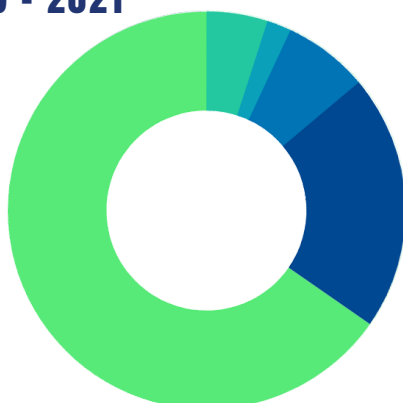
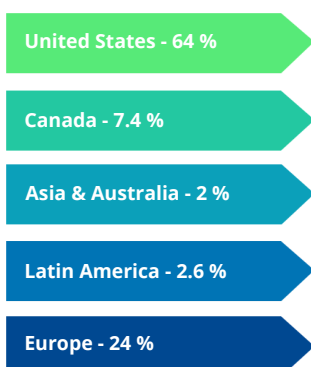
