



Tuxedo Park School COVID-19 Illness & Travel Return to School Policy for 2021-2022 School Year

- 1. Student or Staff has Covid-19 Symptoms and Tests Negative**
 - To return to school the following requirements must be met:
 - No fever in 24 hours (without use of fever reducing medicine)
 - Copy of PCR Covid-19 test result

- 2. Student or Staff has Covid-19 Symptoms and Tests Positive**
 - If student or staff member tests positive for Covid-19, please contact the nursing office immediately. Please submit a copy of Covid-19 test results as soon as they are available. To return to school the following requirements must be met:
 - Quarantined for 10 days and symptoms are improving
 - No fever in 24 hours (without use of fever reducing medicine)
 - Obtain a return to school note from primary physician

- 3. Unvaccinated Student or Staff had Direct Exposure to a Person with Covid-19**
 - To return to school the following requirements must be met:
 - Quarantined for 10 days from date of exposure
 - No Covid-19 symptoms present

- 4. Vaccinated Student or Staff had Direct Exposure to a Person with Covid-19**
 - To continue attending school the following requirements must be met:
 - Obtain a Covid-19 test 3-5 days after exposure and submit results
 - No Covid-19 symptoms present

- 5. Unvaccinated Student or Staff Travel by Public Transportation**
 - To return to school the following requirements must be met:
 - Quarantined for 7 days upon returning
 - Obtain a Covid-19 PCR test 3-5 days after returning
 - No Covid-19 symptoms present

- 6. Vaccinated Student or Staff Travel by Public Transportation**
 - To continue attending school the following requirements must be met:
 - Self- monitor for symptoms
 - Quarantine immediately and obtain a covid-19 PCR test if symptoms develop
 - Obtain a covid-19 PCR test 3-5 days after international travel

Symptoms of Covid-19 include: Fever or chills, cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, and diarrhea
