Applications and recommendations must be completely filled out with all required responses and turned in no later than the deadline (Deadline for incoming freshmen is: December 3, 2021. Deadline for current students is: November 5th for ASB, November 19th for Class Officer, and January 7th for Commissioners by 4:00 pm). No late or incomplete applications will be accepted.

Slide 4 and 5: What is your involvement with KHS (other than the Leadership class)? If you are an incoming Freshmen, what do you plan on doing to be involved at KHS? Incoming freshmen can also highlight their involvement in their current middle school. Current students, please explain specific activities that you have attended and what your involvement was. Include pictures of your participation if possible.

Slide 6: Why do you think you would be best for your desired position? What position would you like to be?

Slide 7: When you graduate from KHS, what do you hope the students say about you?

Slide 8: List 3 teachers (with their email address) that you have sent a copy of the Teacher Recommendation form (located on the Leadership tab of the KHS website) to in order to speak on your behalf. \*

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
