The expression of a student's uniqueness and individuality by means of the student's dress is recognized. Restrictions on freedom of student dress will be imposed whenever the mode of dress in question is a:

- 1. Contrary to law.
- 2. Unsafe, either for the student or those around the student.
- 3. Disruptive of school operations and the education process.

No restrictions on freedom of dress and adornment will be imposed which:

- 1. Reflect discrimination as to civil rights.
- 2. Reflect discrimination as to particular codes of morality or religious tenets.
- 3. Attempt to dictate or adjudicate style or taste.
