GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

De La Salle High School offers subjects that comply with the minimum requirements for admission to the University of California. The school also offers a wide variety of electives which go beyond these minimum requirements. Five (5) semester credits may be earned for the equivalent of each semester course and 10 credits for a full-year course. The total minimum credits required for graduation from De La Salle are 240 semester units (60 units per year) within the following course of studies:

Mathematics	3 years	30 credits

Science	2½ years	25 credits
Physical Education	2 years	20 credits
World Languages	2 years	20 credits
