
# Welcome to Our Class

Jackson is 7 years old in 2<sup>nd</sup> grade, and Rebecca is 6 years old in 1<sup>st</sup> grade.





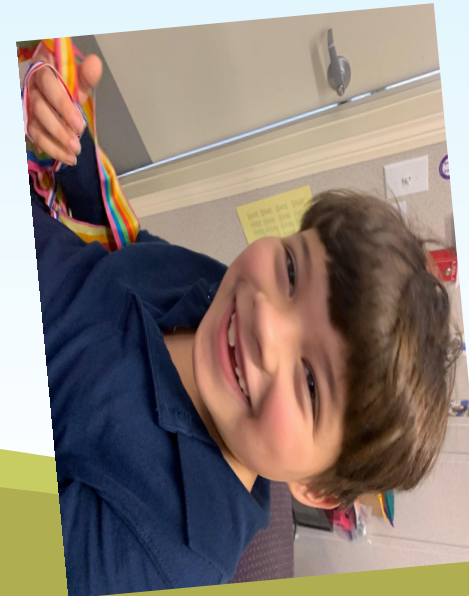
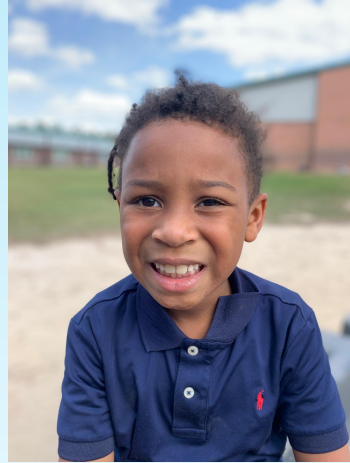
# About Lakechia Taplin
