Review virtual assignments and homework regularly.</li> <li>● Ensure that the school issued technology device is used only for school purposes.</li> <li>● Provide a quiet, lighted place for virtual instruction or study time.</li> <li>● Read with my child a minimum of 20 minutes every day. Child will read 1.8 million words in a year.</li> <li>● Ensure child completes all virtual <u>assessments</u> independently.</li> <li>● Support your child by communicating with the teacher thru class DOJO or email and by attending school programs: award assemblies, STAAR trainings, etc.</li> <li>● Sign up for the Parent Portal (grade information), TEA Parent Student Portal (assessment information), and receive other important Log in information (AR, I-Station, etc.).</li> <li>● Implement Leader in Me</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Attend school every day.</li> <li>● Have supplies and technology device ready.</li> <li>● Make sure you are working on a table (not on a bed).</li> <li>● Dress appropriately (no pajamas, tank tops, etc..)</li> <li>● Read every day at home for a minimum of 20 minutes. Goal: Read 1.8 million words in a year.</li> <li>● Complete and return all virtual and face to face assignments and homework.</li> <li>● Comply with all face to face or virtual directives: camera on, mute and unmute when asked to, join breakout sessions, etc.</li> <li>● Take care of the school issued technology device and ensure that it is charged at all times.</li> <li>● Use technology device appropriately.</li> <li>● Follow the Weslaco ISD Code of Conduct which can be accessed digitally.</li> <li>● Follow The Leader in Me initiative.</li> <li>● Be a buddy, not a bully.</li> <li>● Be respectful to staff, students, and parents.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Provide parents with needed trainings or guidance to assist with virtual or face to face learning.</li> <li>● Ensure Google classroom or SeeSaw is updated regularly.</li> <li>● Provide virtual/face to face and homework assignments for students.</li> <li>● Provide lessons that are challenging and rigorous.</li> <li>● Ensure that all designated TEKS are taught.</li> <li>● Ensure that differentiation takes place: GT, ELs, 504s, Special Ed, Tier 3 Students, RTI, etc.</li> <li>● Update students and parents by providing updated information on the parent portal.</li> <li>● Make learning fun and classroom engaging.</li> <li>● Regularly schedule parent /teacher conferences through ZOOM.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Provide an environment with positive communication between the teacher/parent/student whether instruction is virtual or face to face.</li> <li>● Plan a minimum of 5 learning walks a week to ensure student engagement and academic learning is in place.</li> <li>● Ensure schedules are being followed.</li> <li>● Ensure all parent questions or concerns are answered.</li> <li>● Schedule a weekly staff ZOOM meeting to provide staff with updated information to communicate with parents if needed.</li> <li>● Encourage teachers to provide homework which reinforces classroom instruction.</li> <li>● Ensure CDC guidelines are met to stop the spread of COVID.</li> <li>● Provide a safe, healthy, and bully-free environment.</li> </ul>
