

COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic: SRRHS

Benton County Public Health (BCPH) will be hosting a Pfizer vaccine clinic at Sauk Rapids-Rice High School to coincide with the State of Minnesota's 'Kids Deserve a Shot' Campaign. Please carefully read the information below in its entirety.

Note: Parent/guardian of minor students need not be present for the appointment. However, please provide a parent/guardian's phone number during registration. BCPH will call Monday morning prior to the clinic to confirm consent for vaccine.

Insurance information: The only information required is the type of insurance you have (private, public, Medicare, etc.). Once you select the type of insurance, go to the bottom of the page and click 'Save and Continue.' *There is no cost to families for the vaccine.*

Review Details/Summary Page: You must scroll to the bottom of this page and click on 'Save and Continue' or your appointment will not be saved. A confirmation email will be sent to those who successfully register.

On the day of your appointment: Please arrive on time. Masks are required in our clinics. The entire appointment time should take 20 minutes, which includes a wait of 15 minutes after being vaccinated to monitor for any adverse reactions. Be sure to eat/drink before too!

Second Dose: The second dose clinic will be held on November 22nd, 2021 at the same time of day/location. A registration link will be sent out via email following the first dose appointment.

Kids Deserve a Shot Campaign

Minnesotans 12-17 years old who start and complete their two-dose COVID-19 vaccine series between October 18 and November 30 are eligible to receive a \$200 Visa gift card through the 'Kids Deserve a Shot' vaccine incentives program.

Who is Eligible?

Minnesotans 12-17 must receive their first dose between October 18 and November 9 and receive their second dose by November 30. Minnesotans must be

- at least 12 years old at the time of one or both shots
- and 17 years old or younger at the time of their first shot.

How it Works:

The reward registration will open at 8:00 a.m. on November 9, 2021. The registration form will stop accepting requests for gift cards at 11:59 p.m. on November 30. Gift card requests will be fulfilled beginning on November 30, 2021 and throughout the month of December 2021. Please allow up to 6 weeks after November 30, 2021 to receive your Visa card in the mail. Parents/guardians must enter their 12-17 year old by the entry deadline to be eligible. Parents only need to enter their 12-17 year old once.
