#### Information

Remember that in order to try out for a winter sport, athletes must register on Family ID, turn in a PIAA physical to the Athletic Department, and Impact Concussion Testing completed for freshman and juniors. If you are a freshman or junior and participated in a fall sport you do not need to take the impact test again nor hand in the PIAA physical form. Not having these can affect one's participation on the team. This must be completed by November 19<sup>th</sup>. Registration on FamilyID opened on October 24<sup>th</sup>.
