Having children in one of these schools, I watched as social media blew up on Wednesday evening. If this happens on a weekend or evening in our district, please rest assured that we will contact families as soon as we know anything. It takes time for law enforcement to get to the source. If they can't determine it's safe to attend school, they will let us know.

Regarding social media and safety – teachers at ICS will never require a student to use any communication platform other than Teams. Students may choose to connect with one another using a product such as Discord, but they aren't being asked to do this. I've seen school group-work conversations become negative and personal. As a parent I believe in randomly asking my girls to show me what they're doing on social media. We give our kids the power to connect to the world in a tiny device. They still need us to help them learn how to navigate such awesome power.

- An opportunity to form mentorship relationships with instructors.
- An opportunity to unpack the nuances of Blackness.
