This week we will be exploring Fireworks and Bonfire Night through a range of creative activities— including poetry, song and dance. The children will be making their own firework pictures, thinking of firework sounds and attempting to write them.

In maths we will be continuing to engage in activities that underline the purpose of counting . Children will further practise their 1:1 correspondence skills, by counting numbers at the same time as moving or tagging objects. repeating patterns by making firework arrangements as well as continuing with our work on counting using one to one correspondence and subitising.

In PE we will be developing ball skills by rolling a ball with control alongside some practise of catching a large ball.
