
How To Respond To A COVID-19 Outbreak





School contacts the state Department of Health or local health department for guidance



Health staff works with school to see if closing is needed



A maximum 14-day closing may be recommended if:

Five percent of students/staff have confirmed cases in a 14-day window. That's:

25 CASES: Schools with fewer than 500 staff & students

25-45 CASES: Schools with 500-900 staff & students

45+ CASES: Schools with 900+ staff & students

OR

Three simultaneous classroom and/or core group outbreaks when:

- Contact tracing cannot adequately identify close contacts or be completed in a timely manner
- Other mitigation strategies such as physical distancing or universal masking are not being implemented or adhered to
