

DSD Teacher Classroom Cleaning/Disinfecting Procedure

- 1) Spray tops/sides of all desks/tables, including any cubbies/baskets/etc that are attached. Spray chair seats and front/back of backrests.
- 2) Spray the counter, sink, faucet, and drinking fountain if present.
- 3) Spray the inside classroom door handle and the side of the door where students and staff tend to push.
- 4) If any additional cubbies are shared by students, spray those.

Wait the necessary disinfectant contact time (for Virustat DC Plus it is 10 minutes - if another product please check the contact time for Covid-19 with Terry Woodall or custodian). When the contact time has elapsed, begin wiping at the first desk sprayed with either paper towels or a microfiber towel, if available. Wipe desks and chairs in the same order they were sprayed.

- 1) Wipe tops and edges of all desks/tables. Wipe inside and outside any cubbies/baskets/etc that are attached. Wipe chair seats, front/back of backrest, and edges. Wipe down the legs of desks/tables/chairs at teacher discretion.
- 2) Wipe the counter, sink, faucet, and drinking fountain if present.
- 3) Wipe the door handle and left side of the door. Take the wet cloth and wipe down the light switches (do not spray them directly).
- 4) Wipe the pencil sharpener, if present, with the wet cloth (do not spray directly).
- 5) If any additional cubbies were sprayed, wipe the insides and front edges.
- 6) Take a deep breath and smile :)
