



Central Clinic

Free health care for St. Louis Park & Hopkins youth - infancy through high school

Central Clinic serves:

Young people from infancy through high school who live or go to school (either public or private) in St. Louis Park or Hopkins.

Services are free and include:

- Treatment for acute illness and injuries
- Well-baby checks
- Immunizations **ONLY FOR UNINSURED AND MA/MNCARE**
- Camp and sports physicals
- Sexual health care
- Interpreters can be arranged by calling ahead of time

Walk-in:

- Patients are seen in order of arrival

Consent:

- Written consent by a parent or guardian required annually. (By Minnesota law, students can give permission for their own sexual health services.)
- Consent forms are available at the clinic, in school offices, at Central Community Center, or at slpschools.org/centralclinic

The clinic is staffed by Park Nicollet physicians.
