

## SBISD Natatorium Facility Usage Policies

No more than 500 swimmers to a meet.

Any set up hours will be charged by SBISD and Sweetwater if after normal operating hours. Example: Meet Sat and Sun, set up Friday is charged and hours needed is expected.

SBISD is renting pool, touchpads, starter, bleachers, offices cannot be guaranteed.

The meet director will meet with a SBISD or Sweetwater representative to review meet logistics at least one week prior to the event. Attendees will review a meet check list and both parties will exit with a copy of the check list.

No one can request renting the facility more than 4 months prior to the event.

Meet director will be in direct contact with SBISD and Sweetwater staff with times, meet info, questions, and inquiries.

Any meet with a single day time frame longer than 8 hours. Sweetwater will bill 1.5 hours per each additional hour per/employee.

We don't have control over inside air, office, bathroom, locker room temps. Only on or off if needed and everything is scheduled to be on during planned hours.

No access to coaches' office.

No crockpots, microwaves, coffee pots, or kitchen appliances allowed in the weight room

Touch pads go in after warm ups.

Custodian may be assigned. If extra cleaning is needed there will be extra charges.

Must use sticky tack or blue painters tape.

Any sort of vandalism in and outside of Natatorium, the renter will be responsible.

Lost and found will be held on for 2 weeks.

Must bring your own coolers, ice machine is provided if needed.

Vendors are allowed during the event but at \$100.00 per vendor per day.

No parking or driving on grass. Vending trucks are to be parked in the parking lot.

A SBISD or Sweetwater Supervisor must be present until the competition is completed. Sweetwater staff will open and close the building.

No admission is to be charged by the renter.

2 Lifeguards are to be on duty during the competition.

At least one security officer is to be on duty before, during and after the competition.

Due to a contractual agreement with SBISD, Sweetwater Lifeguard Training does not have to give up diving well water space for overflow water polo club participants during meets or practices.

The renter agrees to restore to original condition any unwarranted destruction of property.

Any agreement to rent the facility can at any time be cancelled by the District.

Permission is not granted for the renter's regular and continued use of Athletic facilities. Only those dates and times stated on the Facility Usage Form will be considered.
